Chapter (Market Rd, Canton) is our Tuesday night venue. Why not join us in the bar after the meeting.

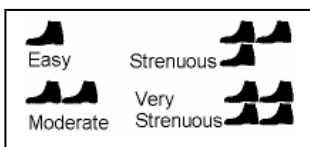
